General Regulations for ATV Pull

- All drivers must be 16 years of age or older (13-16 may drive with signature of parent or guardian.)
- All entries are to be in by 6:30 p.m., Wednesday, July 20th.
- Each ATV can only be entered in two classes.
- Contest is open to either 2 or 4-wheel drive ATVs.
- Only one driver per machine per class.
- Each participant is responsible for lost or stolen items, injury or property damage.
- Each participant has only one pull per class, except in tie or pull-off.
- The first two-place winners must weigh out after each class.
- Driver must remain seated on seat through entire pull.
- At their discretion only, any contestant may opt to advance to a higher weight class, or cc class.
- Machines must have a hitch no higher than the center of the axle, and extending no further rearward than 6" from rear axle.
- Each weight class will include the weight of the machine plus the weight of the driver, and any additional weight.
- All ATVs will be required to weigh in before entering track to pull.
- All ATVs must be operated in a safe manner on and off the track. No speeding or wheelies allowed. (Drivers can be disqualified for this behavior).
- All drivers must wear pants, shirt, shoes & helmet during pull.
- No alcohol is allowed. Violators including drivers & pit crews will be disqualified.
- ATVs must use only two driving wheels. No duals allowed.
- ATV must use only rubber tires. No chains or studs allowed.
- ATVs must have working brakes, fenders over the rear tires, & a spring return throttle (lever or twist).
- No ATV shall exceed overall dimensions 60" wide & 84" long. This will be measured at the widest & longest points.
- The first puller in each class is the "Test Puller". They have an option to re-pull in third or last position. However they will be giving up their first pull in doing so. Decision to re-pull must be made before ATV leaves the track.
- All ties must re-pull, an average between the two pulls will determine winner.
- If the ATV goes out of bounds during pull you are done.
- The puller will be given two consecutive attempts to start the sled.
- All pulls will start with a tight hitch. No jerking is allowed.
- The standard track will be 20 feet wide & 200 feet in length.
- Only pump Gas or Diesel is permitted as fuel, neither nitrous or pressurized fuels are permitted.
- The officials will settle any discrepancies in the rules and their decisions are final and must be accepted in a sportsman-like manner.
